Trustee Hendricks offered the following, and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, 75% of all seasonal operations of the DPW Department are completed utilizing the 2004 Ford Dump Truck (F-350). And

WHEREAS; The 14-year-old truck has experienced mechanical problems requiring extensive repairs and increased maintenance. And

WHEREAS, The difficulty in obtaining parts for the truck increases down-time, delays seasonal operations and results in very high maintenance costs. And

WHEREAS; The cost to benefit ratio for this old truck far exceeds that of a newer truck. And

WHEREAS, The warranties on a new 2019 truck are expected to result in less out of pocket maintenance costs than could be achieved with purchasing a newer used truck. And

WHEREAS, The New York State Office of General Services has a current state contract for a 2019 Ford F-350 XL Reg Cab 4x4 comparable replacement truck at a cost that will not exceed \$31,000. And

WHEREAS, a compatible new 9-foot 2-3-yard Dump Body and a V snowplow are necessary to complete the required truck service package can be purchased locally at a cost not to exceed \$15,000 and

WHEREAS, NY Local Finance Law § 11.00 (28) indicates probable useful life of the new truck is 15 years

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Oxford Board of Trustees

- 1.) Authorizes the purchase from Van Bortel Ford, 71 Marsh Rd., East Rochester, New York via NY State Government Contract (Onondaga Bid 7974 2019) a 2019 Ford F-350 XL Reg Cab 4x4 at a cost that will not exceed \$31,000.
2. Authorizes the purchase from Palmer's Truck and accessories LLC, South Canal Street Oxford New York a new 9' Rugby 2 to 3 Yard Dump body and a New Fisher 9'6" Extreme V plow and controller to fit new truck at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.
- 2.) Declares the 2004 Ford F-350 Dump Truck be surplus property and to be sold at auction at a minimum bid offer of \$10,000 at a date following the date new truck is placed in service.
- 3.) Authorizes truck purchase to be funded by the combination of proceeds from the sale of the 2004 Truck and the Village unallocated fund balance not to exceed \$46,000.
- 4.) Authorizes and directs Mayor to sign all documents necessary to complete the purchases and installations as soon as possible.

Seconded by Trustee Leach.
